Re: Interest Rate on Unpaid Contributions

Dear Contributing Employer,

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of a change in the amount and timing of interest, fees, and penalties being assessed on delinquent contributions owed to the Operative Plasterers' & Cement Masons International Association Local 262 Pension Fund and the Northeast District Council of the OPCMIA Fringe Benefit Funds (the "Funds"). Effective July 1, 2022, in addition to any other remedies which may exist under the applicable Collective Bargaining Agreement ("CBA") to which your company is bound, or to which the Funds may otherwise be entitled, an Employer who fails to pay benefits by the 30th day following the end of the week in which covered work was performed shall be considered delinquent and shall be obligated to pay interest at a rate of 10% per annum and liquidated damages at a rate of 20% of the delinquent contributions. This is in addition to any expenses incurred in auditing the Employer's books and records, or imposed by the Trustees, plus all additional payments required because of any arbitration or litigation, together with all expenses of collection incurred by the Trustees (including, without limitation, attorneys' fees, administrative charges, auditing fees, imputed costs of audit as per the CBA, and court costs). This 10% interest charge will also be assessed on contributions found to be due and owing through an audit.

If an Employer fails to remit the amount demanded by the Funds for unpaid contributions, and legal action is commenced, the interest the Funds will seek in litigation on such unpaid contributions will increase to 18% per annum. Our hope is that this letter will encourage prompt and complete payment of contributions owed to the Funds, such that enforcement of the Funds' rights is unnecessary. Thank you for your time and attention to this important matter.


