Dear Contributing Employer:

This is to inform you that the Board of Trustees of Operative Plasterers and Cement Masons Local 262 Pension Fund and the Board of Trustees for the NEDC of the OPCMIA Welfare, Annuity, Vacation, Apprenticeship, and LMC Fund pursuant to the Collective Bargaining Agreement ("CBA") between your company and the Plasterers and Cement Masons Local 262 and the Fund's trust agreement, have retained the services of Fitzsimmons Abrams, LLP to perform payroll compliance audits on behalf of the Fund.
